The table is a hand carved by Charles Haupt, an industrial designer based in Cape Town. These abstract forms take inspiration from the thorns of the native South African Num Num shrub. This indigenous tree with its sharp thorns is often used as a protective hedge around homes. Haupt uses natural curiosities when experimenting with various traditional and contemporary techniques, resulting in a masterfully balanced and beautifully elegant work of functional art. All the designs are inspired by blurring urban developments and nature, industrial and organic forms. Using modern fabrication and traditional bronze sculpture-casting techniques results in magical and elegant collectible works of art and design. Due to the intricacy of this table, it is near irreplicable. The glass on the table is provided by de Le Cuona. An alternative dark oak table top is also available. Each piece is one of a kind.
